



Violations Cases




Sources of the cases

SAIP received **67** cases directly from the Plaintiffs at the Authority's premises. **115** cases were conducted through Inspection site visits. **308** cases were conducted through an Online Inspections. Finally, **42** cases referred by the Ministry of Media to SAIP.



IP Infringements Regions

Around **61%** of the copyright violations occur in Riyadh, **24%** in Mecca region, **14%** in Eastern Province, and **9%** in rest regions around Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Examination:


At this stage, carrying out an objective evidences examination and prepare a comprehensive detailed report.

Investigation:

Based on the values of the indication examination reports. At this phase, cases legally studied along with hearings minutes platform reports and exchanging responses between parties, in the case of filing a complaint. Finally, prepare an integrated case file in preparation of submitting it to the in charge responsible Authority.


Dismissed:

Some complaints were dismissed due to uncompleted requirements.




Type of Works

Type of Works








Execution statistics

119 resolutions were issued by the copyright Committee to Review Violations of the Copyright Law. Which were referred to the Intellectual Property Respect Department for execution.

These executions were varied between **Public and private right**, warning, websites blocking , and dismissing the case.

308 Blocked websites resolutions were issued by the Permanent Internet Committee.






Copyright Enforcement Campaigns

Procedures


Confidential surveillance process on the suspected shops and areas of violating intellectual property rights, by directing qualified secret spectator to act as a beneficiary or the customer.

Target

Gathering an accurate information which is related to targeted shops and warehouses, using collected methods in order to target the Inspection campaigns.

Outcome

Exploring critical ways of violations along with methods examinations that drives to identify violated areas. Finally. analyzing collected data during campaigns in order to conduct the Inspection successfully.



Mystery shopper tasks



In this stage the team starts collecting information through market studies, field surveys and Preparing a detailed report through a dedicated electronic system.

This report contains: Monitoring violating facilities, tracking distributors of violating materials and the method for concealing violating materials.

Which results in: A high level of professional studies that leads violating Inspected markets as well as an accurate study regarding security around the targeted areas.

Planning and Training


Training

Planning

Planning for a raid is the most important stage because, Inspectors will get along on the exact track and plan to remain conducting the raid efficiently without any corruptions.

Its purpose to build partnerships with entities to help reaching and tracking violated targets. Also, spreading IP Anti-counterfeiting awareness to SAIP and specially Inspectors.












Results of the second inspection campaign - the most prominent achievements






Statistic of Intellectual Property Respect - Percentage of violating stores

The Intellectual Property Respect Department had a field inspection campaign on a lot of stores around Riyadh.





The most Important violated practices that detected during the campaign

- Platforms provides the service of uploading any document, even if it is copied and violating IP Rights, and then select one of the centers to print these documents (investigation in progress)
- X Monitoring shop workers providing violated IPTV that includes 221 recent subscription.

X Installing hacked Softwares on PC devices and selling them in a large scale

- X one shop is dedicating devices copying original CD's. .
- Exploring counterfeited books, which are less quality than the original books.









Intellectual Property Respect Council

The protection of intellectual property is an essential element of the national economic policies in countries, and the Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property seeks to enhance the protection of intellectual property by developing the enforcement system in the authority and ensuring the quality of its operations, by activating the role of the private sector, understanding the obstacles and problems facing it, and enhancing transparency between the private sector and SAIP. And coordinating efforts to raise the rate of compliance with laws and regulations.

Customs System

The intellectual property protection system organizes and facilitates the communication process between the Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property and Saudi Customs and rights holders and trademark protectors, and contributes to strengthening the authority's enforcement database.

The goals of this system:

- Facilitate and speed up customs procedures
- Stop cross-border infringements
- Participation of rights holders

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Internal System

The system responsible for following up on the procedures of the cases internally and the system allows receiving complaints and taking statements electronically without the need for the presence of any party to the case

External System

The system is responsible for issues related to field tasks and websites:

- Field tasks
- Notices indicators
- Inspection tasks
- Execution Tasks
- Search and Inspection
- Scadule Tasks from Saudi Customs system



Chapter 06 Destruction Campaigns





The Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property (SAIP), in collaboration with the Ministry of Media confiscated and destroyed

More than 3,500,000

items violating intellectual property rights based on decisions issued by the committee as following: CDs, Copied books, Desktops, Laptops, Memory Sticks,

TV Channels Receivers, Hard disks, Cassettes, and CDs Copying Devices.

The destruction and recycling operations were supervised by the CEO of SAIP, Dr. Abdulaziz Al-Swailem.



The Saudi Authority for Intellectual Property (SAIP), in collaboration with Saudi Customs destroyed

More than 2 Million

They included counterfeit and adulterated products that were destroyed (shoes, clothes, mobile accessories, sanitary ware, and car filters) all bearing well-known trademarks from major international companies, against which the customs committees have issued decisions that these products are counterfeit with the conviction of their owners according to the unified customs system.









Number of Cases

By comparing the number of cases in 2019, we note that there was a strong increase of **180%** in the number of cases.

This increase happened because of the new strategy followed by SAIP to deal with the Corona pandemic, in addition to restructuring procedures and developing special policies .





Sources of the Cases


Also, there is an increase in the field of inspections this year, despite the Corona pandemic.


With the issuance of the Supreme Judicial Council's decision, to transfer the jurisdiction to hear civil and criminal cases to the committee to consider violations of the copyright protection system, and the issuance of the commercial court system, this year witnessed a decrease in the number of complaints submitted to the authority






It is noticeable that Artistic cases form the biggest number of the cases in 2020. This is due to SAIP's focus during this period on violations of satellite broadcasting.






Second inspection campaign - main results







Costumers Communication

Corona Pandemic in The Kingdom

The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia has taken several new precautionary and preventive measures to control and limit the spread of Coronavirus (Covid 19), in order to ensure the safety of citizens and residents in the Kingdom.


